LIHEAP

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is available to income qualifying households and can assist households on their gas and electric bills by paying an amount to the utility company through a Direct Vendor Payment (DVP) or by placing you in a subsidized budget bill via the LIHEAP—PIPP Program. These programs are available from September 1st to May 31st or until funds are exhausted.

PEOPLE’S GAS STW

People’s Gas Share the Warmth (STW) is available to income qualifying households and can assist People’s Gas customers by reducing their outstanding balance by up to \$200. STW is available from January 1st to December 31st or until funds are exhausted.

What You Need

Please be sure to have the following documentation at hand:

- Proof of 30 day income for all household members 18 and older.
- Your most recent gas/electric utility bills.
- Social Security Numbers for all household members.
- Undocumented individuals are also encouraged to apply using their ITIN. If you do not have a SSN or ITIN you are still eligible to apply!

COMED’S RSH

ComEd’s Residential Special Hardship is available to income qualifying households who have experienced an economic hardship within the last 6 months. This program helps qualifying households reduce their outstanding balance by up to \$500. RSH is available from January 1st to December 31st or until funds are exhausted.
