

Background

- WisDOT & IDOT propose an increase to Amtrak's Hiawatha service from 7 to 10 round trips
 - 1. New track to hold 2-mile long freight trains adjacent to existing Union Pacific tracks
 - 2. New universal crossover switch proposed on Metra tracks south of Dewes Street
- Community concerns with Amtrak's \$195M proposal:
 - Project Need
 - Project's Environmental Impacts
- History:
 - Release of Environmental Assessment (EA) Oct. 2016
 - Project Public Meeting Nov. 2016
 - Public comment period ended Jan. 2017

 - <u>Communications</u> planning, educating, mobilizing, implementation - \$50,000.00 contract with Jasculca Terman
 - Research engineering, rail, traffic, and environmental consultants; project alternatives - \$100,000.00 (TBD)
 - Lobbying \$50,000.00 (TBD)
 - <u>Litigation</u> potential NEPA violation; environmental issues -\$100,000.00 (TBD)
 - Contingency \$100,000 (TBD)
