## Neighborhood Background

- Platted and built around 1954-1960
  - Built to engineering standards of the time
  - No local sidewalks


Prior sidewalk requests <u>not supported</u> by neighborhood

## Village Sidewalk Policy


- Neighborhood must gather signatures and provide a sidewalk petition to the Village
  - 54 Neighborhood-area residents signed (received Nov 2014)
- 2. Village **hosts** a resident meeting with the neighborhood to review conceptual plans and answer any questions
  - Meeting tonight
- 3. Village hosts follow-up meeting/s, as necessary
- Village sends ballots to neighbors directly adjacent to the proposed sidewalk (both sides of street)
  - To be mailed following resolution of any issues

At least **2/3 of those directly adjacent must be in favor** of the project to move forward


## Conceptual Sidewalk Plan

### **Next Steps**

- Follow-up with any questions or information requested tonight (schedule additional meetings?)
- With revised plans, ballots to be mailed to residents
  directly adjacent to any proposed sidewalk
- At least two-thirds (2/3) directly adjacent must vote in favor for the project to proceed
- If vote is successful, project will be brought forth to Village Board with construction potentially coordinated with pending roadway projects

#### Other Pedestrian Studies

- Joint Wilmette-Glenview Traffic Study:
  - Review current pedestrian and vehicle access to Avoca West
  - Improve pedestrian links and roadway crossings (areas bounded by Skokie, Illinois and Hibbard)
  - Improve pedestrian access along East Lake Avenue between Sherwood Road and Skokie Blvd

Field reconnaissance now underway

## Stormwater Background

- Separate sanitary and storm sewer systems
  - Sanitary Sewer Evaluation Study (SSES) complete
- East of Harms Regional Stormwater Project
  - Backflow prevention from River
  - Two new lift stations (50% complete)
  - 84-inch detention pipe along Harms Road
- Local (in-line) stormwater detention
  - To be provided with local roadway projects
