

Natural Resources Commission

The Natural Resources Commission is charged with preserving, protecting and restoring Glenview's natural environment. Among other things, it focuses its efforts on the West Fork of the Chicago River's North Branch as it runs through Glenview (the "West Fork Corridor"), Gallery Park and Kent Fuller Air Station Prairie.

Made up of five Glenview residents appointed by the Board of Trustees, the Commission also includes a non-voting student member.

The Commission:

- Seeks to raise awareness about local opportunities to enjoy and enhance our green spaces.
- Conducted a full assessment of the Village's natural resources.
- Developed and recommended long-term strategic plans for protecting and restoring these areas.
- Coordinates its efforts with local school districts and the Park District.
- Is the final arbiter on appeals to Village decisions to issue or revoke tree-removal permits.

Meetings

Commission meetings are generally held on the **third Monday of every other month at 7 p.m.** at Village Hall, 2500 East Lake Avenue.

Agendas are posted at Village Hall on the Friday before each meeting and can be accessed online at www.glenview.il.us.

Meetings are sometimes canceled or rescheduled. In addition, special meetings are sometimes scheduled to address key issues. To be sure, call the Public Works Department at 847.657.3030, go online to www.glenview.il.us or watch GVTV.

Public Comment at Meetings

Public comment is welcome on specific agenda items at each meeting. Simply fill out a speaker card when you enter the room and give it to the Commission secretary. The Chair will call on you at the appropriate time during the meeting.
