In accordance with the Illinois Election Code and rules promulgated by the Illinois State Board of Elections ("State Board"), the local election official or his/her designee of the Village of Glenview ("Village") determines ballot placement for two or more new parties for the same Village office who filed petitions simultaneously as of the opening hour of the filing period by means of a State Board-Approved lottery procedure.

On Wednesday, December 26, 2018, the Village will conduct a lottery to determine ballot position for all new parties who filed nominating petitions with the Village as of 8:00 a.m. on Monday, December 10, 2018, being the first day of filing for the April 2, 2019 Consolidated Election.

All 8:00 a.m. simultaneous first-day new party filers qualify for the lottery to determine top ballot position. All other ballot positions are determined by order of filing.

The lottery will take place at 8:30 a.m. in the Village Manager's Office at Glenview Village Hall, 2500 East Lake Avenue, Glenview, Illinois, and will be open to the public.

Candidates need not be present.
