1 Zoning

The Village of Glenview is divided into several zoning districts designed to cluster compatible uses together.

Prior to selecting a tenant space, contact the Community Development Department and submit a **Land Use & Zoning Confirmation Request Form** to confirm that your business can legally operate at the proposed location.

Step 2

Staff reviews Land Use & Zoning Confirmation Request

Step 3

Staff issues a letter to the Applicant verifying the proposed use is permitted

2 Licensing and Registration

Business licenses or registration and a Certificate of Occupancy (C/O) are required for all businesses which have locations within the corporate limits of the Village of Glenview. Business licenses are valid for the calendar year with an associated fee of \$35.00. For additional information regarding Licensing and Registration, contact **Staff at 847-904-4307**

Additional Licenses and Approvals

Establishments wishing to serve alcoholic liquor require additional licenses and should contact **Staff at 847-904-4302 or 847-904-4372**

Establishments wishing to serve food or perform massages are required to acquire additional licenses or approvals. Contact **Staff at 847-904-4311 or 847-904-4396**

Licensing and Registration Checklist

Step 1

Applicant submits [Business License Application](#) to Staff

Step 2

Staff reviews submittal to ensure compliance with applicable codes

Step 3

If necessary, applicant applies for all required building permits

Step 4

Applicant schedules required [C/O inspections](#) by contacting Staff at **847-904-4340**

Step 5

Staff issues Business License and Certificate of Occupancy

3 Permitting

Community Development Department staff serve as the initial point of contact for issues related to zoning, permitting, and inspections. All commercial construction projects require a building permit before they commence. **Information regarding the permitting process may be found online at:**
