## EXAMPLES OF TEMPORARY SIGNS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED



Please be advised that many temporary marketing & promotional materials --- such as *pennants, balloons and other inflatables, pinwheels, flashing signs, sandwich board signs, feather signs, and yard signs* --- are not permitted by the Village of Glenview's Municipal Code.

However, the Code does allow for the installation of one (1) **Special Event Banner** upon private property for up to consecutive 14 days, once per quarter, for a maximum of up to four (4) such signs per year.

The requirements for Special Event Banners allow for a maximum size of 32 square feet, forbid the use of pricing information upon the banner, and allow for up to 20% of tenants within a multi-tenant building to display signage at any given time.
